

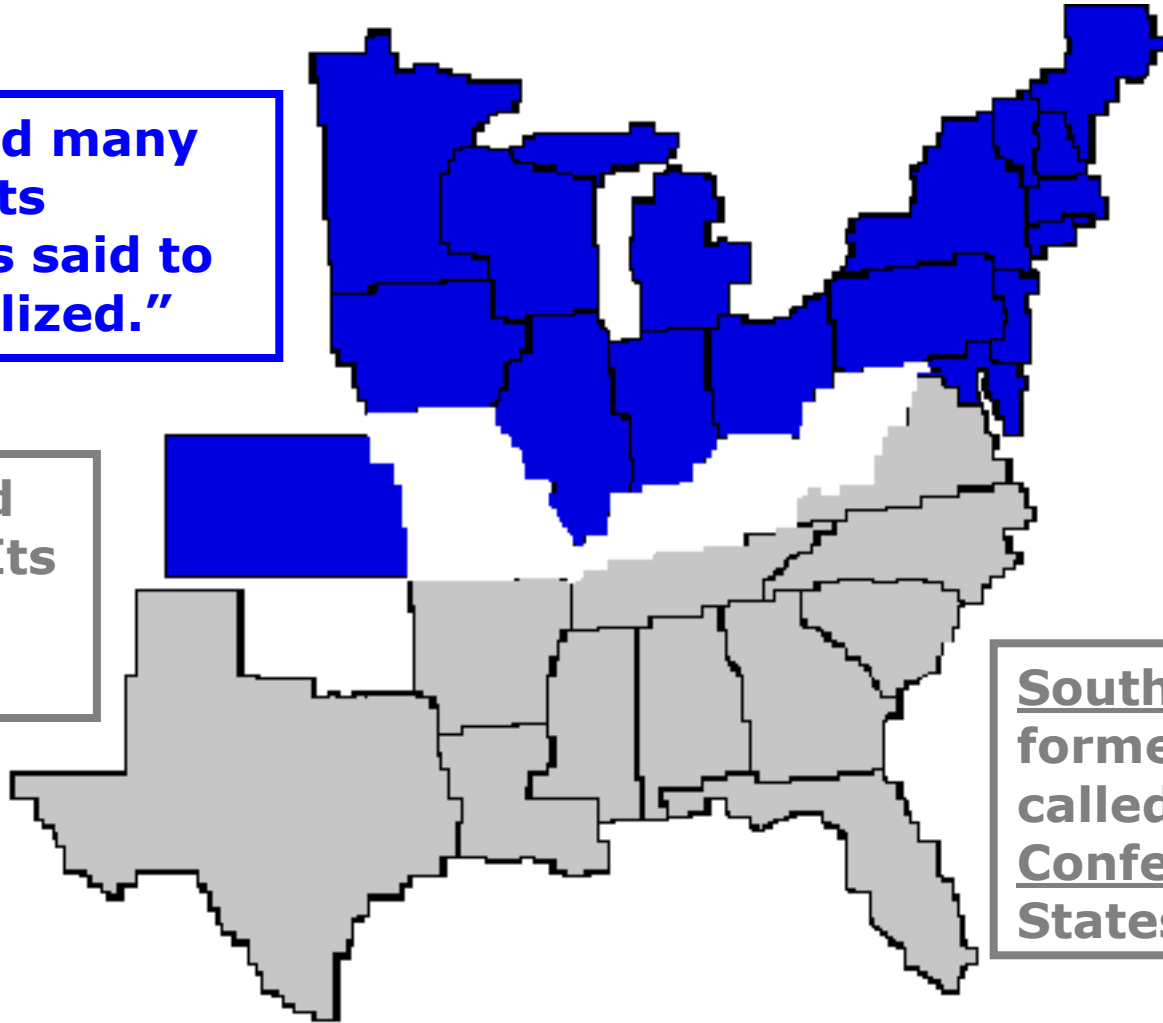
Differences Between the Northern and Southern States
